Coaches would have the freedom to commit to the number of hours worked each week. Successful candidates in these roles will be expected to:

- Provide football coaching and support to a wide range of Football Futures Foundation programs and events
- Work with Football Futures Foundation staff to facilitate the attendance of participants at Football Futures Foundation programs and relevant events
- Liaise and communicate with various stakeholders such as parents, school representatives, local clubs and volunteers
- Assist with registration and program administration including equipment transport and handling
- Maintain records of participation numbers in Football Futures Foundation programs and other relevant information
- Travel to session locations as required

- Self-motivated with a proactive approach to work and a willingness to learn new skills
- Excellent time management, organisational and customer service skills
- The ability to deliver basic football and/or sports content in a wide range of situations
- Football coaching and/or mentoring experience (desirable)
